Changes to the Sailing Instructions

SI § 8.1 Appendix 1 : Racing area

SI § 10.1 Change “orange” to “Yellow” to read

With reference to Appendix B. Marks 1, 1a, 4s & 4p will be Red inflatable marks. Mark 1b will be an Yellow inflatable buoy. Finish mark will be a pink mark.

SI 15 PENALTY SYSTEM

SI § 15.2 Add:

Delete P2.2 and P2.3. So that P2.1 will apply to any penalty after the first one

To read:

15.2 Appendix P will apply, with P2.1 applying to all penalties (changed to a One-Turn Penalty only) and delete P2.2 and P2.3. So that P2.1 will apply to any penalty after the first one

This changes RRS Appendix P.

Add SI 15.3

SI 15.3 (a): A member of the jury who sees a boat breaking a rule in appendix “Hiking rule” they may penalize her by, as soon as reasonably possible, making a repetitive sound signal, pointing a blue flag at her and hailing her sail number, even if she is no longer *racing*

SI 15.3(b) When a boat is penalized under SI 15.3 (a) (above) her penalty shall be a one Turn Penalty under rule 44.2. If she fails to take it, she shall be disqualified without a hearing. (Change to RRS 63.1)

SI 15.3 (c): If a boat is penalized after a hearing of a protest lodged by a competitor about a rule on Appendix “Hiking rule”, the international jury will be impose on her a [SCP] penalty equal to 10% scoring penalty but no more than DNF.

Appendix “Hiking rule”

C.3.3 POSITIONING

- (a) **When sailing close hauled**, crews shall sit facing inboard in such a way that the base of their spine or legs are not on or over the side rails, or outside the forward extension of the line of the side rails and **their upper body is no less than a 45° angle to the water**;
- (b) **When sailing off the wind, hiking aft of the side rails is permitted**;
- (c) No device (except for the foot straps), method or sheet may be used to implement, assist or **enhance** hiking or sitting outboard; other than the foot straps
- (d) **The use of the shrouds (including any inner shrouds) above the lower bottle screw (turnbuckle) to facilitate tacking or gybing, or to aid the projection of a crew member outboard is prohibited.**
- (e) **The use of backstay to aid the projection of a crew member outboard is prohibited.**
